

**Center Harbor Board of Selectmen
Meeting Minutes
High Haith Bridge Final Walk Through
Friday, August 6, 2010**

CALL TO ORDER: At 7:30 a.m. Chairman Richard Drenkhahn called the Board of Selectmen's (Board) meeting to order. Selectmen Randy Mattson and Charley Hanson were also present. Road Agent Jeff Haines, Mike Latulippe of M.E. Latulippe, Inc. and Jennifer Reczyk of Quantum Consultants were also in attendance.

HIGH HAITH BRIDGE: The Board and Road Agent met at the High Haith Bridge to review the completed bridge with the engineer and contractor who performed the work. The Board inspected all aspects of the work and found it to be satisfactory. Two additional items of work were discussed. It was decided to loam and seed some small additional areas to provide vegetative stabilization. Mr. Latulippe indicated that this would be done before the end of next week so the project was fully complete. The Board thanked Mr. Latulippe and Ms. Reczyk for a quality job. The Board discussed a concern about speed on the road and how to address it. Speed limit signs will be placed before the bridge. Please see Quantum Consultants engineer reports for specifics about the completion of the project.

There was discussion about the parking at the beach and the limited use of the beach observed by the Board over the last month. The Board briefly discussed the addition of a dock at the beach and the shallow conditions that exist. Regarding the proposed dock, the Road Agent expressed concern over increased traffic and Ms. Mattson was concerned about individuals diving or jumping off the dock.

ADJOURNMENT: At 8:43 a.m. Ms. Mattson motioned to adjourn the Board of Selectmen's meeting. Mr. Hanson seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.
