

**Center Harbor Board of Selectmen
At the Town of Moultonboro Selectmen's Meeting
Meeting Minutes
Thursday August 20, 2009**

Chairman Charley Hanson called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. Present was Selectman Randy Mattson at the Town of Moultonboro Board of Selectmen's regular weekly meeting.

MEETING WITH MOULTONBORO SELECTMEN: The Board met with the Moultonboro Board of Selectmen to discuss the following items:

- Moultonboro was thanked for its contribution to the Center Harbor Fourth of July fireworks celebration and it was noted that there were a number of positive comments from visitors and residents in Center Harbor on this years celebration.
- Update to High Haith Bridge. Center Harbor gave an overview of the status of the project. Moultonboro asked if the project was going in to next year, and if so, want to make sure they commit the funds to the hydrant project for which they will be paying. Center Harbor will let Moultonboro know as soon as they have a better idea of the schedule.
- Moultonboro was asked about their beach sticker program as the subject has come up in Center Harbor. The Board responded that the program has worked well. They have a police cadet in the summer that enforces the rule. This seems to make it effective.
- The Boards discussed the recent hiring of a Town Planner in Moultonboro. At this point, the Board gives the planner high marks and is pleased with the addition.

ADJOURNMENT: At 7:42 p.m. Ms. Mattson motioned to adjourn the Board of Selectmen's meeting. Mr. Hanson seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.
