

**MINUTES OF THE
CENTER HARBOR CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

March 2, 2010

The meeting convened at 10:05 am.

Attending were: Bruce Bond, Chairman; Harry Viens; and JoAnn Wood, Secretary
Randy Mattson represented the Board of Selectmen. In fact, there were

I. The minutes of the February 9 meeting were read and approved without correction.

II. The commission was brought up to date on

A. The Planning Board. Work on the master plan continues apace.

B. The Energy Committee. Harry reported that the committee is still awaiting the results of its two grant applications, together totaling more than \$400,000.

C. The Center Harbor Woods. Randy reported that attorney Peter Minkow is acting for the town in this project as Doug Hill is representing the LRCT. She also reminded the (much reduced in number) commissioners that title will be transferred on March 4 and that the bell-ringing celebration will take place on March 6. And foo on you who don't make it.

D. The Prime Wetlands/Natural Resources Inventory studies.

- Thanks to Moe, Sandy Crystal's request for confirmation of the town's approval has apparently been satisfied
- Bruce confirmed that he will invite Rick van de Poll to attend our next meeting, April 6. In addition to discussing the above two studies, the commission would like to review with Rick
 - - Possible additional lands that would qualify as prime wetlands (e.g., Snake River, Fog Hill Bog)
 - - The cost implications.

III. Permits and applications. The commission received one dredge and fill application – Charles and Wendy Harris (check that) in Dog Cove – to replace the existing boat house and dock with larger structures and to build a marine railway line. We await DES response with a certain degree of fascination.

IV. New Business

A. The conservation coordinator for Belknap County would like to discuss with the commission various conservation issues.

B. There was also a rather mysterious letter concerning a proposed eight-lot subdivision in the Coe Hill Road area.

And with no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 11:05 am. The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, April 6, 2010.
