

Minutes of the  
**Center Harbor Energy Committee**  
April 1, 2010

Meeting was called to order at 7:08 PM.

In attendance: Chris Johnson, Harry Viens, Bernie Volz, Charley Hanson.

Resident Barry Borella attended and expressed concern about 2 items:

Amount of time street lighting was on.

Converting some stop signs to yield signs to conserve energy.

Committee agreed to take this under consideration but will pass the ideas on to the Selectmen because they involve safety issues and highway regulations.

Chris J reviewed available NHEC efficiency programs and applications were completed and signed by Selectmen Hanson. Rebate application for TJI evaluation was completed (and has been submitted to NHEC – 50% up to \$5,000). A meeting has been arranged with Atlantic Energy Services on 4/6/10 to perform a detailed estimate of the lighting and control systems at the Municipal Bldg, The Library and the Highway Garage. 50% rebates are available from NHEC. Proposal will be ready for review at next CHEC meeting.

Insulation upgrades for the Municipal building were also introduced. Further discussion was postponed until after a review of the building by Architect Gary Goudreau which will identify long term/short term renovations.

Committee reviewed feedback from grant application. Comments included CHEC was on lower end of savings calculations (maybe we shouldn't have included some of the lesser savings items), not as much savings information backup, lower end of savings to dollars spent ratio.

Committee will review the list of low cost/ no cost items identified in TJI review by next meeting to implement asap.

Brief discussion on Energy Savings Tips handout.

Next meeting is scheduled for May 6, 2010 at 7:00 PM.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:45 PM.
