

Minutes of the
Center Harbor Energy Committee
June 3, 2010

In attendance: Harry Viens, Charley Hanson (selectmen's representative), and Bernie Volz.

Because a quorum was not present, no votes or actions were taken. Instead, the issues on the agenda were discussed.

1. The Atlantic Energy Solutions project to update the lighting in the Municipal Building (Town Offices and Fire Station) and Highway Garage is moving forward. This will cost the Town \$6055.44 but should save \$2120/year in electricity and thus will pay for itself in less than 3 years. The NH Electric Coop will cover the remaining ~\$5,000 of the cost.
2. Charley Hanson stated that one of the Municipal Building boilers is leaking and will need to be replaced. The selectmen will investigate options and discuss efficiency options with the Energy Committee. Some energy conservation funds may be used to offset the increased cost for a more efficient unit.
3. The no/low cost items in the Jordan Report were discussed. Most items are unlikely to be worth implementing, but the fan thermostat for the Highway Garage and working to reduce drafts should be investigated.
4. The energy considerations handout is still with Ken Ballance; Charley Hanson has action item to follow up.

The meeting ended at 8:10 PM.
