

In 2006, the Space Needs Committee found Center Harbor Police Department to be the most critical need of the town. The Building Committee has been working since July 2008 to find the best solution for Center Harbor.

- After public input at town hearings on 2/14/2009 & 10/24/2009, a redesign of the police facility was done to incorporate the feedback, thoughts, and concerns of our residents.
- The new design will meet the current and future needs of the Center Harbor Police Department without unnecessary expenditures.
- The proposed location keeps the building on town property, saving the town from having to purchase land.
- Creates a feeling of a municipal center for our residents and visitors.
- The design will enhance the park space by making it more useable for everyone, and beautifying the area while maintaining 84% of the park's green space.
- Library Trustees and the Board of Selectmen, among others, have given their full endorsement.
- **There will be minimal to NO tax impact to our residents due to expiring bond items and other savings.**
