# Center Harbor Board of Selectmen Meeting Minutes and 2018 Budget Hearing Minutes Wednesday, February 7, 2018

<u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: At 7:00 p.m. Chairman Richard Drenkhahn called the Board of Selectmen's meeting to order. Selectmen Harry Viens and Richard Hanson were present. Police Chief Mark Chase and Fire Chief Leon Manville were also in attendance.

<u>METROCAST FRANCHISE FEE</u>: The Town received \$12,833.29 from MetroCast for the 2017 franchise fee.

**REACH THE BEACH RELAY RACE**: Chief Chase reported the Reach the Beach Relay Race will be September 14 – 15, 2018; the racers usually run through Town between 6:00 p.m. until 2:30 a.m.
