Who can borrow? Anyone with a valid Nichols Library card!

What do you need? A computer, web access and a compatible media player (see NH Audio for a list of compatible devices). Download the Overdrive Media Console or Adobe Media Editions (for E-Books) and you are on your way.

How does it work? At NH Audios, log in with your library card. Browse titles and add them to your cart. Download them (3 at a time) to your computer and transfer them to a portable player (either WMA or MP3 compatible). You can burn selected titles to a CD.

How long do I keep them? items stay on your player for 7 days.

Can I place a Reserve? Yes! You will be notified by email (only) when your requested title becomes available. You have 48 hours to download the book. If you already have 3 titles checked out, you may not check out your reserved title. So be careful how many checkouts and you reserves you have at one time.

How do I Get Started? The NH-Overdrive website has a "Help" section that takes you step-by-step through setting up an account and downloading books. They also have a guide to compatible players and readers. For detailed instructions on using your nook, Kindle, iPod, etc, go here.
