- I. <u>MINUTES</u>: Peter Louden motioned to accept the November 7, 2017, minutes. It was seconded by Mark Hildebrand. All were in favor.
- II. **PUBLIC HEARING: ADU SECTION 5:9:2 CHANGES FOR 2018 TOWN ORDINANCE** Chairman asks if any Board Members have any questions or comments about the changes that are currently proposed for Town Meeting. With no comments from the Board the Chairman opens the hearing to public input.

Bob Beem is upset the Board did not take into consideration any of the information/suggestions he provided during the September 19th meeting. Bob revisits the points he made during that meeting.
