### **UPDATE NRSPR - RED HILL FARM ROAD 215-010**

Chairman updates the board on a potential NRSPR for the property located on Red Hill Farm Road, formerly the Belknap College/Red Hill Inn/Music Festival property. Chairman states the property owner would like to reclaim a previously approved use and it has been requested by Ken Ballance that the property owner submit an application to the Board for review. The topic of possible "events" at this location was brought up, the Chairman said he was not aware of any such requests. According to Ken's discussion with the property owner, the use will be less intrusive than what had been approved previously. Clerk states the application has been submitted however, the fees associated with application submission must be received before the hearing can be scheduled. Tentative hearing date set for April 3<sup>rd</sup>.

#### AIRBNB

Question was asked by a Board member if there are any restrictions in the Town on Airbnb. Chairman states there are no Town regulations but that it appears the State is working on addressing Airbnb rentals. The Board at some point, may want to have a discussion regarding Airbnb and adding Town regulations to zoning.
